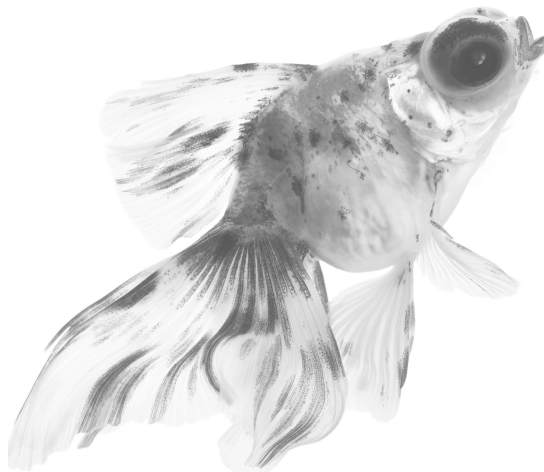

PET SITTING VS. DOG WALKING

We are frequently asked about the difference between Dog Walking and Pet Sitting. Dog Walking is simply that: a daily Dog Walk with no additional services. Usually, these are Monday-Friday, mid-day visits while people are at work.

Pet Sitting refers to a broader range of services , and applies to a wide range of animals. Pet Sitting includes complete care of the pet and their home. Usually, this means in-home pet care for travel or illness.

At York Professional Pet Sitting and Dog Walking we offer a variety of customizable services, ranging from Daily Dog Walks and Potty Breaks, to High Energy Backyard Play, Cat Care, Vacation Care, and Home and Plant Care.



SCHEDULING

A modern and professional pet care business should make things as easy as possible for their clients. Make sure your pet care provider has easy to access, 24/7 online scheduling so that your information is not lost, and a visit will not be missed.

York Professional Pet Sitting and Dog Walking services hundreds of clients every week, and we are constantly growing. Online scheduling enables us to be organized, ensuring we never miss a visit.

MEET AND GREET

Meet and greets are a very important part of the process of hiring in-home pet care. Before you hire a pet care company, you should be able to meet with them for two simple reasons: they will be coming into your home and looking after your beloved pet.

During the meet and greet, your pet care provider should:

- Review the information you have filled out online and make sure there is no missing information.
- Show you how to book a visit.
- Ask how your pet walks on the leash.
- Determine what special commands are preferred.
- Ask to be shown the location of litter boxes, scoops, baggies, leash, pet-appropriate towels, food and other required items.
- Find out how to operate their crate if needed.
- Cleaning instructions, alarm system operation, and house key testing.



MIX AND MATCH YOUR SERVICES

Look for pet care services that will allow you to mix and match according to your needs, and those of your pet. You may want both Dog Walking and Pet Sitting services with a variety of duration in the same day if you are away on vacation, or have multiple pets.



PET SITTING

Pet Sitting visits are for those who need someone to care for their pets while away. Whether that's at work, vacation, or illness, we are always here to help.

All animals have their own particular needs. Look for Pet Sitters who have experience caring for a variety of animal friends. The following should always be included in their service:

- Feeding.
- Fresh water and bowl clean.
- Potty break and/or playtime.
- Medication administration.
- Litter, tank or cage cleanings.
- Safety and wellness check.

Look for a pet care service that offers a range of visit lengths so you can customize. For example, a short visit in the morning, a long visit with a play time or dog walk before bed. Duration should range from fifteen minutes to an hour or longer if required.

DOG WALKING

Your dog is a member of your family. They should not be kept home all day without a break to stretch their legs, relieve themselves and socialize.

Look for professional Dog Walkers who will spend the majority of their visit walking, playing and being active with your dog.

Do not allow your dog to be walked in a group unless they are already used to it.

Look for professional Dog Walkers who are attentive to how your dog prefers to be walked. This includes knowledge of the various kinds of leashes, collars, head halters, and harnesses, and how to safely use them.

Your pet care provider should dry your dog off, and clean their paws before re-entering your home.

Providing fresh water a wellness check, and cleaning up after any accidents or messes is a must during every visit.



BENEFITS OF PROFESSIONAL DOG WALKING



Crating your dog at home all day without relief can cause many behavior and health problems. Having had a walk, and playtime before you arrive home, your dog will not be hyperactive and begging to go out. It will also help your dog combat weight gain, immobility related joint issues, and other disruptive behaviors. Please use caution when using anything other than Professional Dog Walking Services. Your pet family deserves the best.

SAFETY AND SECURITY

Look for a pet care company that has rigorous standards when it comes to your pets safety and health. Ensure your pet care service follows these procedures:

THEY SHOULD NOT let them off leash until the door or gate is closed.

THEY SHOULD do a walk around of your house to ensure there is nothing dangerous easily accessible to your pet.

THEY SHOULD be conscious of the heat and cold. So as not to expose them to dangerous temperatures, your pet should get enough play time in your home or backyard.

THEY SHOULD assess the fitness of your dog on every visit to ensure they are not ill or distressed or lethargic.



BONDED AND INSURED

Any pet care company you consider should have Pet Sitting insurance, and any team members should be covered under it too. Look for a company that is bonded and uses a police background check as part of their employment process.

Accidents do happen, and since your property is our workplace, we want to make sure you are never liable for accidental injuries or damage.

BACKUP

Your pet-sit or dog walk should never be missed. Every team member should have a backup. If they cannot make the visit at the agreed upon time for whatever reason, another professional team member must take over for that visit.

PET FIRST AID/C.P.R.

All team members of your pet care company should be trained in Pet First Aid and CPR. We pride ourselves on continuing education through Pet Sitters International to keep up to date on the best practices for pet care.
